Your gift of \$3600.00 on October 11, 2011 to American Red Cross Disaster Relief helps people affected by disasters like hurricanes, floods, fires and tornadoes as well as countless crises at home and around the world. In late summer, Hurricane Irene, Tropical Storm Lee and the Texas wildfires prompted a massive response, with the Red Cross sheltering and feeding those affected in approximately 20 states. In response to Hurricane Irene, thousands of Red Cross workers staffed approximately 500 shelters from North Carolina to Maine. When rains from Tropical Storm Lee left communities in states like New York and Pennsylvania flooded and forced tens of thousands of people to evacuate their homes, the Red Cross opened shelters and sent additional disaster workers and supplies to the area. And in Texas, where wildfires raged and consumed hundreds of homes, the Red Cross offered safe shelter to hundreds of affected residents, and supported emergency responders by serving them drinks and snacks with the help of partner organizations. Thanks to donors such as you, the Red Cross response to Hurricane Irene, Tropical Storm Lee and the Texas wildfires was immediate.

Internationally we are also providing staff, supplies and funding for the relief operations led by our Red Cross and Red Crescent partners.
